Webinars—A webinar on the NWS flood inundation mapping program with a case study on the Rock River in Wisconsin was held on September 26th with 224 attendees. The NWS focuses on flood forecasting but USGS also has a program that develops inundation mapping for communities. They are collaborative efforts. We plan to have a webinar in the future that will focus on USGS flood inundation mapping. It recently has been announced that the Subcommittee on Hydrology has approved the recently completed Bulletin 17C. Thuy indicated that Colorado has completed a revision to the hydrology for the Colorado River and would be willing to do a webinar on the project as a case study.

Thuy subsequently provided acceptable dates. AL reached out to Robert Mason (USGS). Robert is willing and will contact Thuy to coordinate with her on conducting the webinar on November 16th.
