

Cooperating Technical Partners – ASFPM CTP subcommittee Monthly Call

April 11, 2018

CNMS webinar with Bradford Hartley is up next for May 11th. Announcement provided to Laura at the end of March so that it could go in the April and May CTP Collaboration Monthly newsletters. After that will be 2D or BLE (July –August). Hydrology CLOMR/LOMR and appeal – for potential webinar after that.

LiDAR – discussed USGS 3DEP – lidar acquisition process as a possible topic. While USGS has a Frequently Asked Questions document, it is not clear as to what counts as non-federal cost share for the USGS 3DEP. HUD CDBG funding has been determined to be non-federal but others less certain. LiDAR QA/QC process had been discussed on our last call. Extraction of buildings is another possible topic.

Best Practices – may need to use the webinar ideas or come up with an alternative to do a write up for Best Practices.

Steve story sent some info to the group on using LiDAR to estimate lowest adjacent grade. Minnesota process for using LiDAR for LOMAs is another option.

Considering writing up Minnesota's process of having a floodway meeting with communities during the mapping process to promote high standards floodways. MN only allows 0.5 rise (the MN standard) if no buildings are impacted. FEMA has a related floodway guidance document.

Carey indicated Louisville has lower surcharge (0.1 foot) floodways.

ASFPM conference in Phoenix – Jennie provided a list of possible places for the Monday evening simple ice breaker, looking for venues. There was not a lot of commingling at the event in Kansas City. Will need to send out a notice early enough before people book flights. Possibly have some budget for providing food.

CTP award – having it during the FEMA keynote presentation at the Tuesday luncheon instead of at the M&ES committee meeting on Monday. Someone from FEMA HQ will be there to announce the CTP and CRS awards.

Dave requested setting up a call to discuss logistics of the CTP meeting at ASPM in Phoenix, will talk to Steve to see if it can wait til next call in May.

Next call will be on May 10th at 11 CST instead of May 9th at 2 pm due to conflict with CTP CoP call.

Carey is tasked to start up TMAC subcommittee to reach moonshot of doubling policies by 2023, looking for SME, will send out a short scope to this group.
